- ❖ Create opportunities to welcome you into the life of the school community

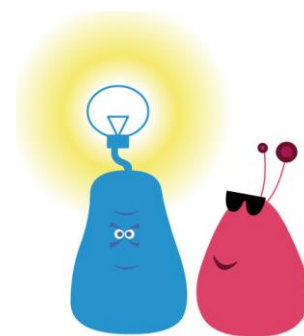
