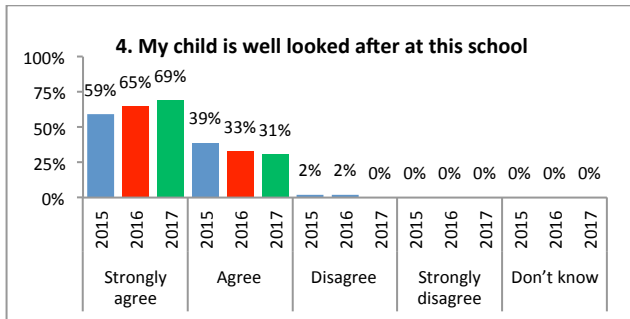
- All of my children are very happy at Blue Coat

- My children always seem happy to be at school and have made good relationships with staff and peers



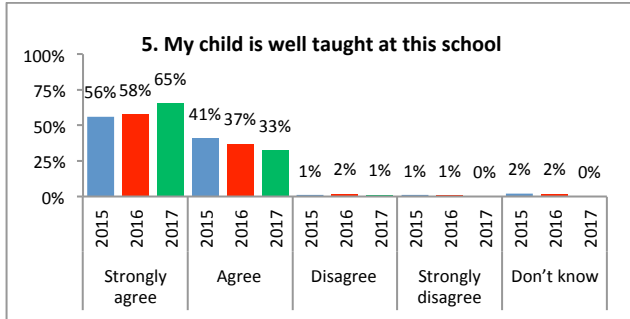
- They feel safe

- I like the new dismissal arrangements and I know they are always safe while on site



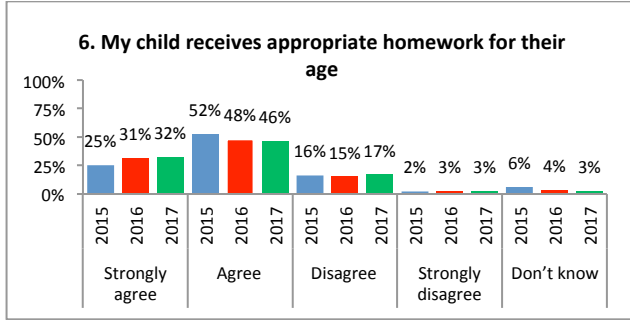
- Reading and maths showing really good progress

- There is a real sense of our children being looked after here.

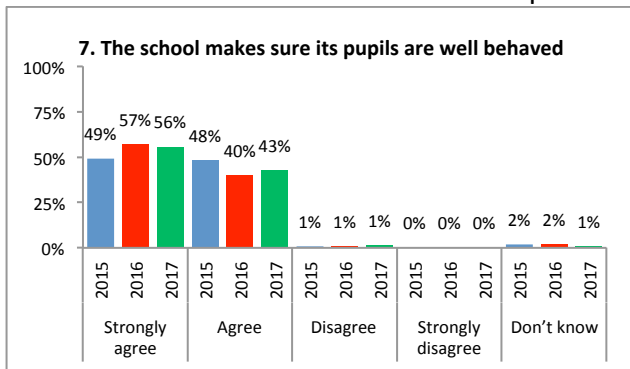


- Love how challenged they are!

- I think the quality of teachers and teaching is high.

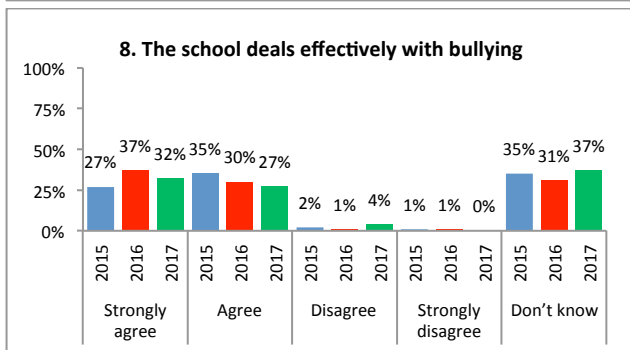


- Great homework grid – lovely balance of activities!

- The home learning grids are excellent. They are a good way of teaching independence

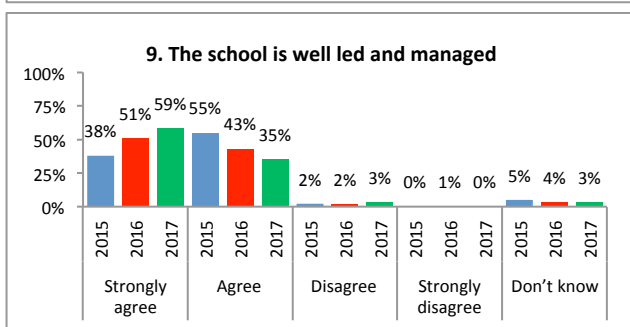

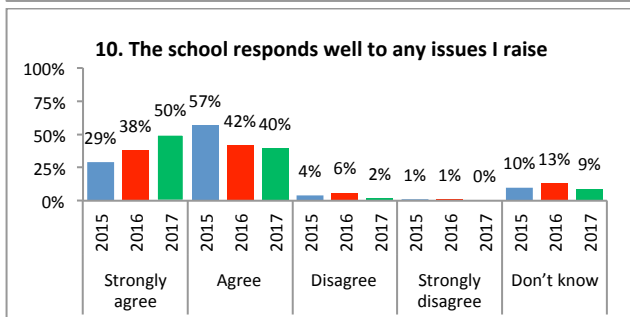
- They are taught good values and behaviour

- I like the interpretation and practice of Christian values



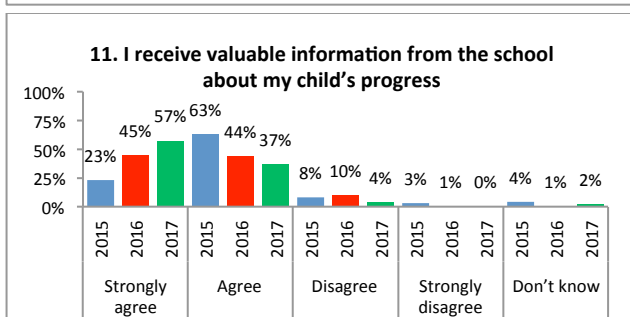
- Only had one issue and it was dealt with straight away

- Have seen examples of this happening over the years to good effect



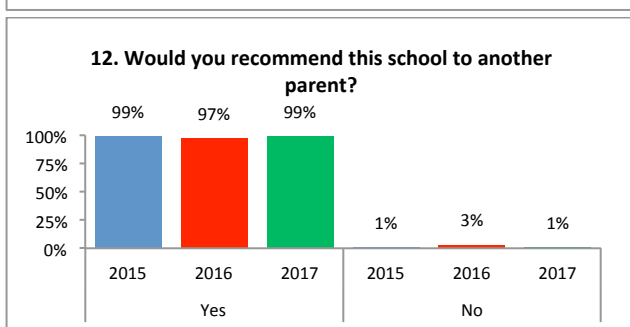
- I am really impressed at how innovative and well organised the school is, as well as being friendly and accessible
